Call 300.

Calling Warriors of Substance to walk in their might taking back what the enemy has stolen in the knowledge that if God is for us who can be against us. (Romans 8:31)



Warrior's of substance.

Substance means *sound and solid*, from the Latin root substare, which means

"to stand firm".

Warriors of substance are warriors who stand firm in their faith as they proclaim the victory of Yeshua, **trusting not in themselves and their own inability** but in Yeshua and His ability to do what seems impossible.

Considering One plus God is a majority!

Yeshua attained the victory on the cross, so that we as recreated in CHRIST JESUS can enforce the victory, crushing the head of the enemy. The implementation of this victory on earth is now in die hands of the "Church". Therefor Satan is directing his attack against the Church, as in Gideon's example. Satan's purpose is to rob the full effect of the finished work of Yeshua, by stealing or corrupting the Good seed sown by Yeshua.

We as believers are no longer free to live as if there is no war. We need to understand the scripture of 2Ti 2:4 No soldier gets entangled in civilian pursuits, since his aim is to please the one who enlisted him.

As believers in Yeshua we need to ask some serious questions:

- 1) Am I expressing the enmity that God put between the devil and the Body of Messiah? Or am I seeking peace through compromise?
- 2) Am I available to my Lord as an instrument, ready to be used?
- **3**) Am I aware of my covenant responsibility in the spiritual conflict, as taught in Scripture?

The battle of Calvary was won on the praying fields of Gethsemane. Yeshua won the battle with a one sentenced prayer, "not My will be done, but Thy will be done."

Based on Ezekiel 37:1-10, the discipline of being a watchman is simple, yet effective :

- First, acknowledge that you do not know, but that **God knows** all things.
- Second, **listen en proclaim** what you have heard **from God**.
- Third, trust in the fulfilment of the Word you spoke in faith as you received it form God, **proclaim it in the authority of the name above all names, Yeshua the Messiah**. Of whom it is written in 2 Corinthians 1:19-20 For the Son of God, the Messiah Yeshua, who was proclaimed among you through us (that is, through me and Sila and Timothy) was not a yes and no Man; on the contrary, with Him it is always "Yes!" For however many promises God has made, they all find their "Yes" in connection with him; that is why it is through him that we say the "Amen" when we give glory to God. (CJB)

The problem is not with the victory that our Father in Heaven achieved through His only Son Yeshua the Messiah. The problem is the uninvolved believer, who do not want to proclaim the victory because of the sacrifice and inconvenience it requires. Consequently the "church" has lost its power to attack, we have become like Gideon before God called him. We believe but we are not prepared to go in the might of what we believe as we trust in God to do what only He can do.

Gideon's plan was to save a part of the harvest, God's plan was to save the whole harvest, and to set the people free from the continued attacks on the harvest.

Warriors of Substance "Attempt great things for God, as they expect great things from God!!!!"

A warrior recognises the call of God and based on his knowledge that <u>God is who He says He is</u>, he responds in obedient faith, trusting in the call of the Lord. Therefore let us consider Peter as he responded on the call of Yeshua walking on the water.

Matthew 14:28-29: But at once Yeshua spoke to them. "Courage," he said, "it is I. Stop being afraid." Then Kefa called to him, "Lord, if it is really you, tell me to come to you on the water." "Come!" he said. So Kefa got out of the boat and walked on the water toward Yeshua.

Peter who knew the voice of Yeshua was ready to put his trust in the Lord saying

"Lord, if it is really you, tell me to come to you on the water."

He asked for a confirmation, that would beyond any doubt, prove that it was Yeshua. But the confirmation was not in the call of Yeshua, but based on the ability of His Word to enable Peter to walk on the water, as Peter put his trust in Yeshua.

Gideon and his 300 mighty warriors won the battle **against all odds** f or God's glory!

The clay jar that Gideon had to break in order for the light to shine through, is like a prophetic act. Illustrating that for the victory to be won **we need to be broken** so that Yeshua living within us, can be revealed.

The shofar likewise illustrate the proclamation of God's unadulterated Word, as in Isaiah 55:11.

The combination of the two achieved the victory. Yeshua being revealed as we come in agreement with the Word of God, living in us. The Sword of the Spirit as we proclaim the Word of God in the knowledge that it will not return empty but will be victorious over the enemy!

For this victory to be won, we must be **in agreement** with the **covenant relationship.**

The enemy defeated the Israelites based on the fact that they moved out of the covenant relationship by allowing the Baal altar within their camp thereby forfeiting God's protection.

This has always been the primary plan of the enemy for he knows that he is a defeated foe. Therefore he tries to influence us to be indifferent to the covenant relationship with God, so that the victory Yeshua attained on the cross has no effect.

The Call 300 is built upon the Godgiven STRATEGY of Gideon and his 300 mighty warriors:

- 1. <u>Identify the enemy and his strategy of attack.</u> As with Gideon, the enemy knows that if God is for us he will not be able to destroy us. Eg.The strategy to defeat Israel was by allowing idolatry in their camp, the baal altar at Gideon's father's house.
- 2. **Repentance** in order to come into agreement with God's Word, breaking down the baal altar and repairing the breach in the wall. (Covenant relationship)
- 3. <u>Attacking</u> the enemy in submission (James 4:7) to the covenant, and proclamation of the covenant relationship that God established between us and Himself through His Son Yeshua the Messiah. As it is written in Revelation 12:11"They **defeated him because of the Lamb's blood** (The Covenant) and because of the message of their witness. Even when facing death they did not cling to life. (CJB)
